GRACE BAPTIST CHURCH 60TH CELEBRATION

Grace Baptist Church, will celebrate sixty years of serving God and the community on Sunday, July 23rd, 2017 with a special worship service at 10:15 a.m.

The first worship service of the congregation consisted of seven persons and was held on July 7, 1957 at 3:00 PM in an unfinished store in the Antioch Shopping Center. By February 1958 there were 49 members attending. At the time of the Charter there were 66 members.

Ground breaking for the first building containing the sanctuary and basement, was held in April 1960. Grace became known as the "hard-working church" because everyone pitched in to lay tile, paint walls and make partitions. Walls with rollers were constructed so they could be rolled around to create temporary rooms in the basement. The original building was dedicated on April 23, 1961, and by May 1966 the mortgage was paid off. But, the congregation was not through growing and turned around immediately to construct the east wing on the building and add a baptistery to the sanctuary. The east unit was dedicated in July, 1967.

In July 1968, Rev. Harold McMullen ended his pastorate at Grace. During his 8 years of leadership the membership grew from 70 to 211. In February 1970 a Men's Brotherhood and a Boy Scout troop were organized. The next year, 1971, a Women's Sewing Circle was formed. In 1973 the east wing was paid off and carpeting and air-conditioning were added to the buildings. The next year faceted windows were installed in the sanctuary.

Construction began on the Narthex and west wing in 1981. In 1989 Rolling Hills Community Church was formed by Grace Baptist and James Walden was called as pastor. From 1990 to 1997 a Korean congregation met in the Grace basement. In August of 1992 Grace Day Care was opened after 8 months of planning and in 1996 final payments were made on the Narthex and the West Wing additions.

In 2008-2009, Karen immigrants began worshipping with us and soon formed their own congregation which now shares our facilities. Since its founding, Grace Baptist Church has been served by 15 pastors and interim pastors. Our Purpose Statement: "As a living body united in Christ and empowered by the Holy Spirit, the purpose of Grace Baptist Church is to enable our fellowship to know God personally, to love God completely, to love one another and to share God's love with all people."

From the desk of the Clay County Sheriff's Office

Beware of this Phone Scam So You don't Become A Victim!

We've had a few repeat scams pop back up in our area, one of which is a man calling and claiming to be a Clay County Deputy. If you should receive such a call remember these things:

- 1 We will NEVER call you to let you know you have a warrant for your arrest and demand a gift card or prepaid credit card. If you actually have a warrant, we'd just come and arrest you.
- 2. We won't (and can't) call to tell you that a relative is in jail, and demand a prepaid card or gift card for their release. When posting bond on a warrant or new charges all inmates go through the exact same process, and having a gift card or prepaid card aren't part of it.
- 3. **If you get a phone call about a warrant** for "Failing to Appear" for your "Federal Grand Jury Duty" and the caller demands cash or a prepaid card, see #1 and ask them if they want fries with that.

The advice of the Clay County sheriff's Office Is - if you get one of these bogus calls just hang up. DO NOT give them any money or personal information. Spread the word so that your friends, family and neighbors don't fall for it either!
