For the last five years, the cataract has blinded her right eye. She was unable to see the exact face of her child. She came to our eye clinic where she was operated on. Even though with just one part of her eye, Ms. Willemine can see her child and the rest of her family members.

Willemine will no longer stand at the beautiful gate of the temple as the crippled man did, but she is now jumping in joy, ready to join the crowd in the temple. All this is possible because you care.
