Pastor's Message

EASTER THANKSGIVING

As I review the events of Easter and the past 16 months with Grace Baptist Church, I am driven by a spirit of thanksgiving more than anything else. Here is my thanksgiving list.

- •New and good friends. I retired from a position where good friendships are hard to cultivate due to a differentiation of power (that is a management term) often felt between faculty and administrators. Grace refreshed my soul by teaching me again the joy of mutual friendships which I hope to maintain in the future.
- •Memorable road trips. I enjoyed our trips through Missouri, Kansas, South Dakota, Illinois and Nebraska over the past year and have many pictures to remind me of our good times. Thanks for the conversations, the insights and the learning.
- •Intercultural diversity. On Sunday we recognized new members in March with a salt and light ceremony. There were two of Asian descent, two of African heritage and two from European stock. Grace reminds me of heaven which will be populated by people from every tribe, every nation, and every language all singing praises to the our God. Fiscal realism. I am pleased that Grace does annually what the USA cannot do—balance her budget. The church knows her financial revenues (and seeks to increase them) and thus lives within those limitations. Good ministry can be done with the resources God is supplying, whatever they are.
- •Women's leadership. Last spring I was surprised to learn how active the Baptist Women's Ministry is at Grace and beyond. Great Rivers ABWM has been in the past and is presently very dependent on the women of Grace Baptist Church. These servants of Christ supply many resources and significant finances for the work of the Kingdom. Internal ministry. The members of Grace Baptist Church seem to like each other and sincerely want to carry one another's burdens. At church on Easter Sunday people were gathered around Pat Kirk, Kathy Hodge, Rich Hill and Peggy Dunn for prayer and encouragement.
- •External service. But also on Easter weekend, GBC was trying to help those outside the congregation with ministry to two Family Promise families, a loan to a new neighbor, gifts to America for Christ Offering, and a neighborhood Easter egg hunt. And the Grace Day Care is running full steam today.
- •Two congregations. The Karen-speaking congregation and the English-speaking congregation respect each other and both want the other group to succeed. I have experienced no paternalism in this unique relationship. Each is willing to assist the other and to make the necessary adjustments required to share resources for the worship of our God and service to His creation.
- •Physical plant. The Church seems to know that its acreage and our square footage is not an idol to be worshipped and protected but rather a tool to be used and regularly serviced. In the past eight days the buildings were used for 5 Sunday worship services (include Easter Sunrise), housing and meals for homeless families, day care for working parents, 4 meals hosting over 30 each time, Easter pageant, an indoor Easter egg hunt, 3 baptisms, weekly prayers, Sunday school and more. Yet the building is clean and once again the baptistery worked and new plantings at the north entrance will improve the ambiance of the physical plant.
- •Lay and professional interdependence. There is a good mutuality between Beth and the church during the week and Chris and the church over the weekends. Lay people need professional skills of others and the paid staff need the support and friendship of the laity. I am grateful for this good interplay at GBC.
- •Joy in ministry. I am grateful today for the joy of new members coming to Grace as well as the baptisms, funerals, baby dedications and other high points of ministry with this good congregation. We all need an occasional success to stay motivated through the daily expectations.

Thank you for your kind words and for your regular prayers and encouragement. I hope to keep in touch with Grace and rejoice in your good ministry in the Kingdom of God.




