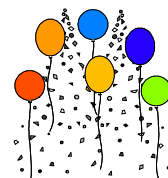

- 9** The WMO enables IM to **expand the cultural and contextual knowledge** needed to help local churches and individuals focus their giving and participation so that they can grow as ministry partners.
- 10** The WMO allows IM to **maintain beneficial missional relationships** with the American Baptist Churches USA, American Baptist Home Mission Societies, Baptist World Alliance, All Africa Baptist Fellowship, Asia Pacific Baptist Federation, Baptist Women’s Union of Latin American, Caribbean Baptist Fellowship and European Baptist Federation, creating environments of trust and respect for our global workers.
