The Bread of Life Chapter: John 6

I hope you have enjoyed reading and rereading John 6 over this past month as we looked at The Bread of Life chapter in the New Testament. I had hoped to finish this series on Sunday as we review the public's reactions to Jesus' claims as expressed in Capernaum. She helps them learn to use resources available locally and improve the health of all on crisis and non crisis situations.

Kristy is a pediatric nurse practitioner and also has a Master’s Certificate in International Nutrition. She served as a pediatric nurse practitioner in the Dominican Republic for 12 years. She also assisted in response to the 210 crisis in Haiti which was created by a giant earthquake.

Greetings. Today, Wednesday, August 8, 2018 was that day one wished to relive again. I left the house early to go to Bas-Limbe to see how the new pump they were digging was going. The road is rocky like tap-dancing. I prayed for my tires. Kihomi has been in this village many times with her women for economic development training, supervision or relief ministry. She knows well the needs of the village and recommended this pump.

When I got to the place, I had a big surprise. Women, children were lining to stock water in their plastic containers. The scene started around 10:00 AM and went on until 2:00 PM.

All of them thanked God for the gift of this pump in their midst. The village had not had any drop of rain for months. The rivers are all dried up. Water has become gold in the village.

Scenes like this one revives in us the zeal to be here and to serve the poor, the needy, the people with no names and no titles just in need of water.

Thank you for being the channels God has and is using to give water to those badly in need of it.
