Nyeakia Town is located in Sanoyea District, Bong County, Liberia, West Africa. The inhabitants of the town do not have access to safe drinking water. The same source of drinking water is where laundry activities are carried out and it's also often used as a latrine.

The road network is very poor, most of it is covered by bushes and bad bridges, and pregnant women must walk on these roads for three hours to access health services.

Children are unable to go to school because they must walk through the bush road paths about two hours to the nearest school and another two hours back home, leaving them vulnerable to kidnapers and rapists. Children are kept at home and grow up without education opportunities. The dream for Nyeakia Town:

1. Construction of a seven-room school facility.
2. Provide educational opportunity for the disadvantaged children of Nyeakia Town and its environs.
3. Construct a clinic.
4. Provide access to safe drinking water.
5. Construct road networks.

Garmai Wilson, a faithful member of Grace Baptist Church, has adopted this village as a personal missionary project. She will share on Wednesday Night, March 27, about her ministry there and the dreams for Nyeakia Town.

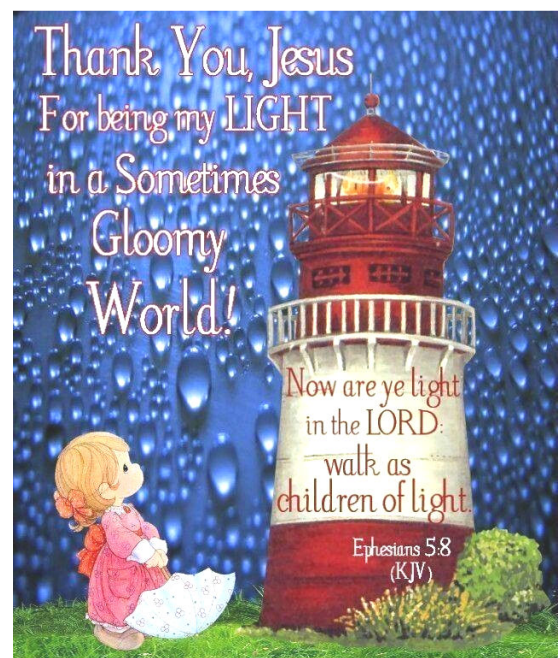

Challenge from Grace Baptist Men: Make a Flood Bucket

Bucket Contents: (If bucket has been used, clean well but do not use if it has held chemicals of any kind.)

- Four scouring pads
- One scrub brush
- Five dust masks
- Seven sponges, assorted sizes
(at least one fairly hefty for washing mold)
- Eighteen cleaning towels (reusable, like Easy Wipes®)
- One 12 oz. bottle of liquid concentrated household cleaner (like Lysol®)
- One 25 oz bottle liquid disinfectant dish soap (like Dawn®)
- One 50 oz. or two 25 oz. bottle(s) of liquid laundry detergent
- One package of 48-50 clothespins
- Clothesline, two 50 ft. or one 100 ft.
- Four pairs latex gloves (long heavy-duty, like Playtex® dishwashing gloves, not the thin ones sold for painting, etc.)
- Two pair work gloves
- 28-bag roll of heavy-duty trash bags (30-45 gallon)

Assembly Instructions:

All cleaning items must be new – all liquid items must be capped and securely tightened.

Place all items into the bucket, making sure they are packed securely to avoid damage during shipment. Snap the lid on tight and seal with packing tape.

Please Note: Do NOT substitute items, add items, or leave items out of the buckets. If the requested item size is not available, go down to the next available size.

Suggestions from **American Baptist Men**: Many items might be available at local dollar stores at a substantial savings. The household cleaner can be difficult to find – be sure it is a concentrated formula.

If items are in boxes (like the trash bags), the box can be removed to conserve space in the bucket. Packaging from the dust masks can also be removed and the mask placed in a zip lock bag.
