Dear Loved Ones,

Greeting. May the peace of our Christ love be yours at this special time of the year. We are praying that in spite of ups and downs of the past year, the new year can bring us all peace of mind and healing in our bodies. Let the Almighty God shower us all with His blessings.

We, the Nzunga's and the people we serve, are coming humbly to thank you each and every one for your fervent prayers, your emails, your cards, your letters, your phone calls and financial support of all kinds. We have deeply appreciated every gift you have posed for us. It is because you care for us and for what we do that we are here doing what God has called us to do. We say thank you very much.

With the three weeks of relative calm, Kihomi started going to Cap-Haitian to meet and train her women. They are projecting a big reunion early next year. Her ministry with students has grown behind our own imagination. Many have come to trust her, and they can sit and share openly for hours. Sometimes her kitchen becomes like a cafeteria.

The calm is slowly returning in the country, but we do not know yet for how long we are going to be calm. The opposition parties do not want to sit with the president for a dialogue. We are expecting more troubles in the new year. Yesterday, Monday, they had troubles in the city of Gonaives. The journalist who was reporting talked about guns being fired.

Officially all schools are closed until January 7, the official date given by the government. Some schools are open, but kids attending with no uniforms. Our university is working on trial basis. Officially we are closing on December 21, 2019 and opening on January 7.

The eye clinic has continued helping those patients who trust and have trusted our caring ministries throughout the years. Yesterday we met and decided that the last day of service will also be our day of special prayer. After service we will sit down together as a family to thank God for His almighty protection, for the patients we have treated and those we will be treating next year, for the people/churches who have prayed for us and have supported our caring ministries. We will be praying for all people from whom we buy our materials. We will also be praying for peace in Haiti and around the world..

Yesterday I went to the hospital of Milot to deliver the orthopedic equipment we received. Their administrator, who received the boxes, was very happy.

We have again started sharing some goats to kids during this time of unrest since they have time to feed their gifts.

Merry Christmas and Happy New year 2020.
