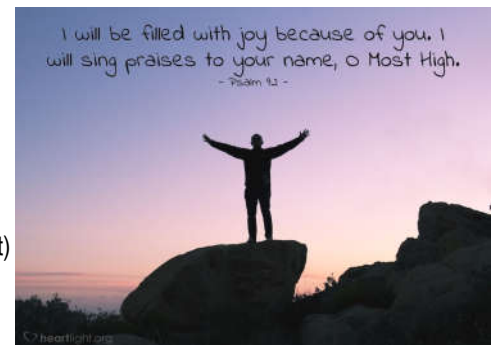

The Choir tours nationally three times each school year and internationally every two years.
