## **America for Christ Offering**

Jesus teaches us to "love your neighbor as yourself" (Matthew 22:39). Grace Baptist follows this teaching of Jesus by reaching out to the community and providing for our neighbors' needs, physical and spiritual alike.

Our church's efforts are supported by American Baptist Home Mission Societies (ABHMS), which provides resources for cultivating leaders, equipping disciples, evangelism and healing and transforming communities.

Grace supports this work through our generous gifts to the America for Christ (AFC) Offering. Each dollar given increases the ministry and impact of ABHMS to serve neighbors with ministries incarnating Christ's love. Further, a portion of this offering (28%) is shared with the Great Rivers Region for strengthening local church leaders in Missouri.

In 2019, our church's AFC gifts supported the following ministries:

- "Rebuilding, Restoring, Renewing Puerto Rico" rebuilding the island one church and one building at a time after several hurricanes.
- Scholarships and Emerging Leaders providing scholarships to students to help ease the debilitating effects of excessive student-loan debt.
- Immigration and Refugee Resettlement partnering with organizations that have resettled more than 100,000 displaced persons from across the world.
- Rizpah's Children partnering with agencies that provide support to children living in poverty.
- Bethel Neighborhood Center, Kansas City, Kansas.
- Judson Press for devotional literature and Bible study materials.
- Additional supported ministries included Disaster Response, Volunteer Mobilization, Prison Re-Entry and Community Outreach Ministries.
